

Council committees

These task committees are open to any union member and they report to the council. Learn more about each one here.



Nomination Committee

(Valberedningen)

The committee suggests candidates for various positions within the organisation, such as the management team, Cortège committee and various boards. Applications open at the end of the fourth study period.

Committee of review of the Cortège

(Cortègens granskningsnämnd)

Assigned to overlook the Cortège and its program. The student union Inspector chairs the committee and has veto on the Cortège's form. Applications open in the middle of the second study period.



Environmental committee

(Miljönämnden)

The environmental committee coordinates and develops the student union's work with ecological sustainability. They help create and improve tools for different parts of the organisation in order to reduce the union's climate impact. Elected in September annually.

Election committee

(Valnämnden)

The election committee handles the annual election for the council. Their task is to ensure a democratic and correct election is held every year.

Committee applications open at the end of the first study period. More on fumval.se.



Committee of election complaints

(Besvärnämnden)

If a student suspects that the general election for council has been carried out in a questionable manner, an appeal should be made to the committee. They investigate the matter and gives a recommendation to the election committee or the council.

Our main areas of operation

The union has many responsibilities, however there are four main areas of operations that includes all things student life.

Student union management team

Kårledningen



These are your student officers who have chosen to devote one year to lead the union on a daily basis. They are elected by the council (*Fullmäktige*) and nominated by the Nomination Committee (*Valberedningen*). The team consists of a board of presidents for each office and their corresponding deputy officers.

The offices are: education, student welfare, corporate relations and management.

The team and its staff is located in the student union building at Johanneberg.



# Student union building

*Sweden's largest student union building, built in 2001, adding on to the existing building from the 1950's. The new part is drawn by architect Gert Wingårdh (A75) and has won the Kasper Sahlin-prize.*





## Conference hall

The Volvo foyer provides impressive spaces for conferences, fairs, banquets and parties.



## Cinema / theatre (RunAn)

Our grand theatre is frequently used as movie theatre, show stage and ceremonies.



## Kårrestaurangen & Hyllan

The main restaurant Kårrestaurangen daily serves hundreds of affordable and well made lunches.

Hyllan is our fancier lunch restaurant with table cloths and table serving.



## Historic hall - Kyrkan

Almost untouched since the 50's, Kyrkan is a fine piece of history and still acting as a comfy living room. The name Kyrkan, the church, refers to the vaulted architecture and was designed by Chalmers professor Melchior Wernstedt.





## Night club - Gasquen

Gasquen is run by students, for students. It hosts a night club and parties as well as "sittning", a dinner that typically precedes a following party. It is the committee GasqueK who is in charge of Gasquen.



## Pub

Our very own pub serves chilled drinks, espresso and typical pub food such as burgers, fish and chips and caesar salads. Popular pub quizzes are held frequently.



## Gym hall

With a serene view, this hall is located on the second floor in the building. Mostly used by sports clubs on campus, but any member can book it for free through Time Edit.



## Music room

Need to get some practice in? Our music room can be booked ahead of time by any union member on TimeEdit.





## Indoor pool

The indoor pool is open almost 24/7, all year, and needs no booking. Just drop by for a swim, before or after lectures perhaps?



## Convenience store

In 2015 we got our own full scale convenience store, providing campus made lunches, snacks as well as gifts, books and stationary. It was a result from the council to ensure better student services on campus.



## Sauna

This shared sauna is located on the second floor and can be used by all members. There are changing rooms just outside. No booking required.

In 2004, the student union received a railway car from the national railway company SJ. It's used for parties, pubs and hangouts and is located just outside the union building.

## **Grand cabin**

This impressive and stunning cabin offer a superb view of lake Sandsjön and can hold up to 120 seated guests. Complete with two floors, bar, sleeping area and a restaurant style kitchen. Perfect for a bigger party.

## **Sports cabin**

Cosy and fully equipped cabin with kitchen, toilets, shower, adjacent sauna by lake, 18 beds and an open fireplace. Bring your mates for a relaxing lake side stay.

## **CS Sauna**

Lakeside wooden sauna built by Teknologföreningen C.S. in 1964 and given to the union on our 100<sup>th</sup> birthday. Equipped with dual heating units (wood and electricity). Presumably the largest student-owned sauna in the world, fitting 60 people.

## **Sleeping cabin**

Cosy, wooden cabin with 15 beds in a shared room. Belongs to C.S. Sauna renters and can not be booked separately.

### **Mottagningskommittén (MK)**

MK works with the long-term development of the reception at Chalmers. We act as the central coordinator by bringing together the student divisions, the student union and the university. To unite all the new students we also arrange the first day at Chalmers, "Tivolit" and "Mottagningskampen".



### **Grand Unified Debuggers (G.U.D.)**

### **Tekniskt Basårs Kommité (TBK)**

TBK is the reception committee for the technical preparatory year, but we also arrange fun happenings as well as study support for the preparatory year during both autumn and spring.



### **Svea Skivgarde**

Svea Skivgarde consists of 13 students interested in music who DJ's at both parties held at Chalmers and off campus. The various music taste within the group allows for a wide range of knowledge in different music genres. Check out our webpage for more info. No previous experience is needed.



### **Chalmers Pyrotekniska Kommitté (Pyrot)**

We are artists painting the sky. Working with professional fireworks, we produce amazing displays for everyone, synchronized with music or just a huge show. We also sell a variety of consumer fireworks if you want to brighten up your special occasion yourself. And of course with a student discount.



### **Charmkommittén (CHARMk)**

CHARM is one of Scandinavia's leading career fairs, arranged by the CHARM-committee every February on campus. Approximately 160 companies from different business areas attend the fair to meet our students and show what they have to offer during and after their studies!



### **Chalmers Film- och Fotocommitté (CFFC)**

We are the Student Union's Film and Photo Committee. We photograph almost all main events within the Student union, everything from the big parties in the union building to smaller events. We makes sure that all of your best memories from Chalmers last forever.

### **Kårhuskommittén (KåK)**

Kårhuskommittén, KåK, works to improve the student union building and the railway car. We want to achieve a nice and orderly building with a touch of cosiness. We are also responsible for making sure that the other people using the building and the railway car does it in a good way.



### **Chalmersspexet**

### **Chalmers Cortège Committé (CCC)**

Every spring Gothenburg citizens gather to behold the Cortège. The parade is created by chalmerists who construct their own vehicles and amusing sceneries. CCC organizes the event, the building week and entertainment in between. Partake in the fun and keep a tradition since 1909 alive: Join the Cortège!



### **Festkommittén (FestU)**

Festkommittén FestU organizes some of the biggest recurring indoor parties in Scandinavia where both people who study at Chalmers and their friends are welcome. The parties contain live acts, numerous bars and dance floors as well as jumping castles and other awesome activities.



# Societies

## Societies - explained

### 1. Independent

Societies are our version of a Swedish "förening". Meaning it needs a board, annual member meetings and acts as its own entity. They need to comply with the unions statutes and policies, but other than that they can roam pretty freely.

### 2. Can use the union's resources & brand

A society can use "Chalmers" as part of their name if they so wish and also get access to the union's communication resources such as newsletter, screens and app.

### 3. Open to all

These clubs are open to the public as well. The only requirement is that half of its members needs to be Chalmers students.

### 4. Anyone, anything!

Sky's the limit. Want to gather all the foodies on campus? Or start a board game club? Or bowling?




