Report 25 — Assessment of the Council Election

The Election Committee is responsible for administering and executing the yearly Student Union Council (FuM) election. Following the conclusion of the election, it is our duty to deliver a report to the council reflecting on the planning, execution, and results of the election. We also include recommendations for future election committees.

Summary

The 2025 election was strained because of a low member count in the election committee as well as not being able to start working as early as usual. Despite that, the goal was to try to retain the high participation from last years election as best as possible while trying to innovate where possible and refine the previous strategies aimed at improving engagement and participation. The election concluded with a voter turnout of **18.1%**, with **50 candidates** standing for election. While this represented a decline compared to the highs of 2024, the election was nonetheless successful in terms of logistical execution, engagement innovation, and continuity work.

We emphasize that the "Cake Day" initiative on April 28th proved exceptionally effective, accounting for approximately one-third of all votes cast during the election. Although the goal of having at least one candidate from each division was not met, the cake distribution event provided significant visibility and engagement, particularly due to its placement near the busy Chalmers Cortège construction site.

Candidature

The candidature period for the 2025 election was carried out according to the timelines outlined in the bylaws. Candidate registration opened well in advance and was supported by structured communication to all divisions. Although we recognize that opening the

registration as early as possible like last year would be advised, it simply wasn't possible and it seems to have been fine even without it.

In total, 54 candidates registered, representing a broad spectrum of divisions and coalitions. But with some drop offs before the election ending with 50 candidates being voted upon. The committee worked proactively to support candidates with portrait photography (in cooperation with CFFC), campaign material templates (with the help of the communication department), and guidance on campaign budgets and procedures.

A strong effort was made to promote early coalition registration to make candidacy more accessible, especially to first-time participants. Despite the effort, not all divisions were represented, and this remains an area for improvement. However, the candidacy process was otherwise sufficiently administered and streamlined compared to prior years.

Notable efforts:

- Mailing list and communications templates created for efficient candidate outreach.
 - Digital registration streamlined via online forms.
 - Physical visibility and giving out candy and chips during the pub crawl
 - PR starter pack and campaign support coordinated via KOM and TT.

Election Execution

The election took place from **April 28 to May 8, 2025**, using Mecenat's platform (karvalet.se) through our website. Despite early delays in responsiveness from Mecenat, the voting system functioned without incident during the election period.

A number of physical and digital engagement initiatives were implemented:

"Cake Day" (April 28)

- Event held at the busy intersection near the Chalmers Cortège construction area.
- Free cake distributed to all students who could show proof of voting.
- Roughly 33% of total votes were cast during this single day.
- Widely regarded as a successful engagement method and recommended for replication in future elections.

Live Tracker

- Reimplemented the live tracker from previous year on the website. A live digital graph visualizing voting rates by section.
- Although no section reached the prize thresholds (20%, 25%, 40%), the competitive format was well received.

Physical PR

- Posters
- Stickers

- Table displays

While the engagement was generally positive, many students were still unfamiliar with FuM and the purpose of the election. On-site representatives from the Election Committee reported that explaining FuM's role often directly led to voting.

Results

A total of **2,365 votes** were cast, corresponding to a turnout of **18.1%**. Grytpartiet emerged as the coalition with the highest number of votes. The election results were published promptly and in accordance with the bylaws. Blank votes accounted for 5.67% of total ballots cast.

Reflections and Recommendations

Key Learnings:

- **Cake Day works.** Physical presence and immediate rewards significantly boost participation. We strongly recommend future committees replicate this strategy to some degree, preferably on the first day of voting.
 - **Live section tracker adds gamification** that encourages competition. It should be retained and better advertised.
 - **Coalition and candidate registration remains a bottleneck.** Despite extensive support, candidate engagement with PR materials and slogans could be improved.
 - **Understanding FuM remains low.** Broader awareness campaigns about the council's role should be considered, potentially through collaborations with current FuM members and the communication department throughout the academic year.
 - **Mecenat platform is reliable, but restrictive.** A long-term move toward an in-app voting system is still recommended.
 - **Start Mecenat coordination earlier.** Their responsiveness before the election period remains an operational risk.

Conclusion

While the 2025 election did not reach the record participation of 2024, it was successful in terms of innovative engagement and operational improvements. The planning, execution, and candidate support were well organized despite the time crunch and a lack of documentation. The documentation issue as well as general organization will be our main focus for the rest of the year to ease the burden and increase efficiency for future generations. And finally lessons learned from this year should provide a strong foundation for future committees to build upon.

The Election Committee extends its sincere thanks to the communication department, CFFC, the Speaker, the Chalmers Student Union leadership and all candidates for their efforts during this election cycle.

We hope this report provides clear insights and inspiration for the Election Committee of 2026 and beyond.

We emphasize that the "Cake Day" initiative on April 28th proved exceptionally effective, accounting for approximately one-third of all votes cast during the election. Although the goal of having at least one candidate from each division was not met, the cake distribution event provided significant visibility and engagement, particularly due to its placement near the busy Chalmers Cortège construction site.

Candidature

The candidature period for the 2025 election was carried out according to the timelines outlined in the bylaws. Candidate registration opened well in advance and was supported by structured communication to all divisions. Although we recognize that opening the

registration as early as possible like last year would be advised, it simply wasn't possible and it seems to have been fine even without it.

In total, 54 candidates registered, representing a broad spectrum of divisions and coalitions. But with some drop offs before the election ending with 50 candidates being voted upon. The committee worked proactively to support candidates with portrait photography (in cooperation with CFFC), campaign material templates (with the help of the communication department), and guidance on campaign budgets and procedures.

A strong effort was made to promote early coalition registration to make candidacy more accessible, especially to first-time participants. Despite the effort, not all divisions were represented, and this remains an area for improvement. However, the candidacy process was otherwise sufficiently administered and streamlined compared to prior years.

Notable efforts:

- Mailing list and communications templates created for efficient candidate outreach.
 - Digital registration streamlined via online forms.
 - Physical visibility and giving out candy and chips during the pub crawl
 - PR starter pack and campaign support coordinated via KOM and TT.

Election Execution

The election took place from **April 28 to May 8, 2025**, using Mecenat's platform (karvalet.se) through our website. Despite early delays in responsiveness from Mecenat, the voting system functioned without incident during the election period.

A number of physical and digital engagement initiatives were implemented:

"Cake Day" (April 28)

- Event held at the busy intersection near the Chalmers Cortège construction area.
- Free cake distributed to all students who could show proof of voting.
- Roughly 33% of total votes were cast during this single day.
- Widely regarded as a successful engagement method and recommended for replication in future elections.

Live Tracker

- Reimplemented the live tracker from previous year on the website. A live digital graph visualizing voting rates by section.
- Although no section reached the prize thresholds (20%, 25%, 40%), the competitive format was well received.

Physical PR

- Posters
- Stickers

- Table displays

While the engagement was generally positive, many students were still unfamiliar with FuM and the purpose of the election. On-site representatives from the Election Committee reported that explaining FuM's role often directly led to voting.

Results

A total of **2,365 votes** were cast, corresponding to a turnout of **18.1%**. Grytpartiet emerged as the coalition with the highest number of votes. The election results were published promptly and in accordance with the bylaws. Blank votes accounted for 5.67% of total ballots cast.

Reflections and Recommendations

Key Learnings:

- **Cake Day works.** Physical presence and immediate rewards significantly boost participation. We strongly recommend future committees replicate this strategy to some degree, preferably on the first day of voting.
 - **Live section tracker adds gamification** that encourages competition. It should be retained and better advertised.
 - **Coalition and candidate registration remains a bottleneck.** Despite extensive support, candidate engagement with PR materials and slogans could be improved.
 - **Understanding FuM remains low.** Broader awareness campaigns about the council's role should be considered, potentially through collaborations with current FuM members and the communication department throughout the academic year.
 - **Mecenat platform is reliable, but restrictive.** A long-term move toward an in-app voting system is still recommended.
 - **Start Mecenat coordination earlier.** Their responsiveness before the election period remains an operational risk.

Conclusion

While the 2025 election did not reach the record participation of 2024, it was successful in terms of innovative engagement and operational improvements. The planning, execution, and candidate support were well organized despite the time crunch and a lack of documentation. The documentation issue as well as general organization will be our main focus for the rest of the year to ease the burden and increase efficiency for future generations. And finally lessons learned from this year should provide a strong foundation for future committees to build upon.

The Election Committee extends its sincere thanks to the communication department, CFFC, the Speaker, the Chalmers Student Union leadership and all candidates for their efforts during this election cycle.

We hope this report provides clear insights and inspiration for the Election Committee of 2026 and beyond.
